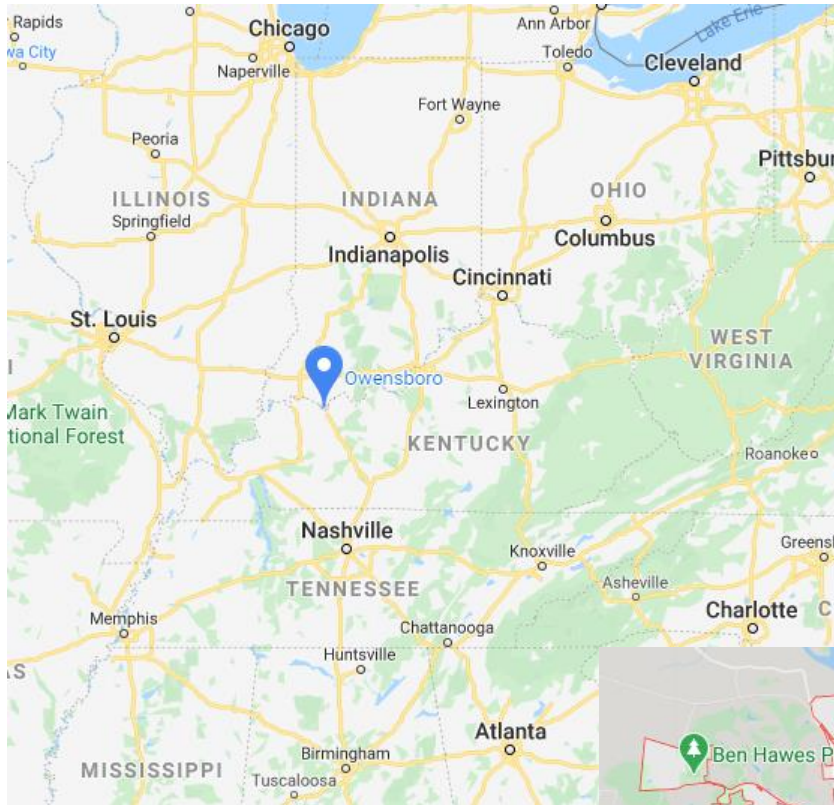
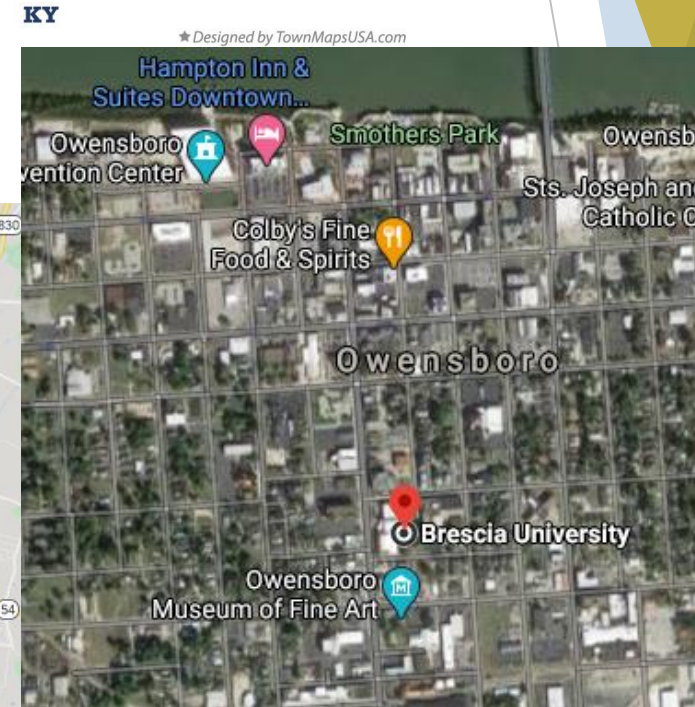
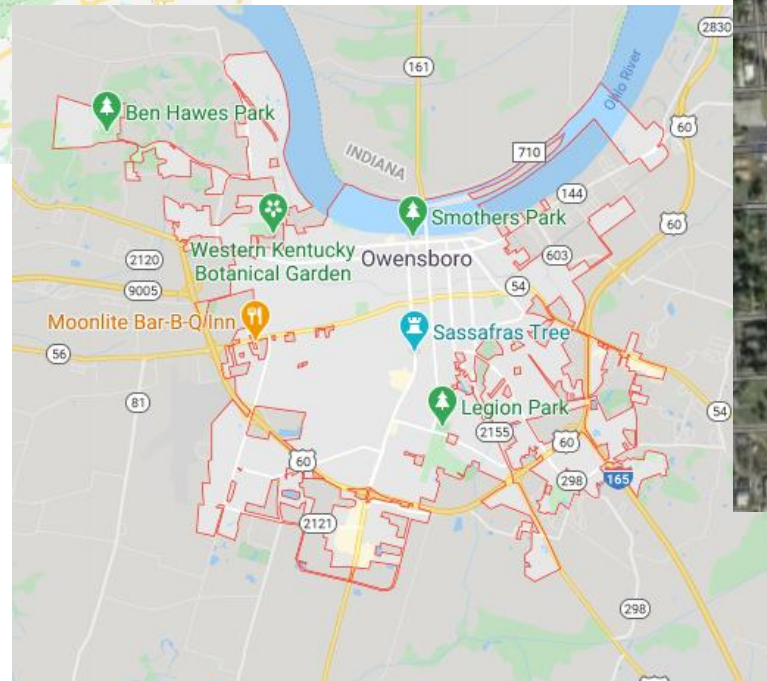




Our town at a glance!



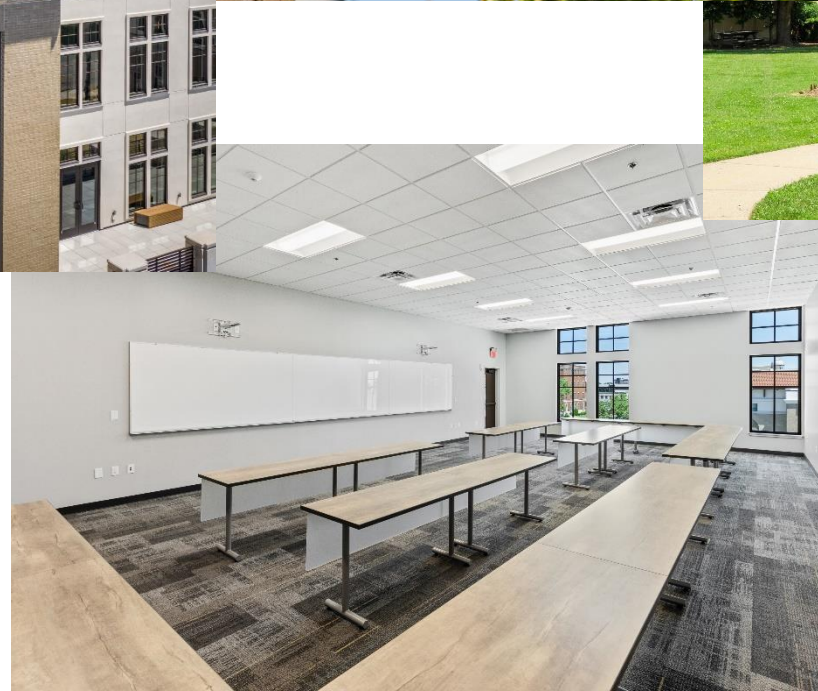
- Population: 59,809

Liberal Arts

Definition: Academic subjects such as literature, philosophy, mathematics, and social and physical sciences as distinct from professional and technical subjects.

- 40+ Majors
- 3 professional schools: Business, Education, and Social Work
- Associate and Masters programs available

Catholic



- Founded by the Ursuline Sisters in 1925
- Approximately 50% of the student population is Catholic
- Mass is non-denominational but not required
- Students of all backgrounds welcome
- 6 credits of Theology are the only religious requirements
- Flexibility to be as involved as you would like in faith and ministry

Student Activities

Admission Requirements

- 2.5 unweighted GPA
- 18 ACT or 970 SAT
- FREE application
- No letters of recommendations required
- 3.5 unweighted GPA and 25 on ACT to be eligible for Honors College



Scholarships

- Academic scholarships
 - \$5,000-\$20,000 per year available
 - Catholic Connection Grant
 - 50% off tuition
- Moore Presidential Scholarship
 - Invite only
 - Must be awarded Trustees scholarship
 - Deadline to apply – Dec. 1
 - Essay required
 - Interview
- Henry E. and Mary Williams LaRue O'Bryan School of Business Scholarship
 - Invite only
 - Must be awarded Ursuline scholarship or above
 - Deadline to apply – Dec. 1
 - Essay required
 - Interview
 - Business majors only
